Today's high schools are increasingly based around the use of digital technologies. In-depth case studies are presented of the adoption of personalized learning apps, social media and 3D printers. These investigations all lead to a detailed understanding of why schools make use of digital technologies in the ways that they do. *Everyday Schooling in the Digital Age: High School, High Tech?* offers a revealing analysis of the realities of contemporary schools and schooling "drawing on arguments and debates from various academic literatures such as policy studies, sociology of education, social studies of technology, media and communication studies.
