Finding Your Career Path Without Losing Your Mind

The PATHFINDER Language Arts workbook series - now available for grades 3-8 - provides students with guided instruction and strategy-building exercises in order to help them develop essential language arts skills. Elements of good writing (including Sentence Structure, Word Variety, Spelling, Punctuation, Openings, Details, and Conclusions) are demonstrated through examples and comparisons with poorly written text. Each of the three types of writing prompts that typically appear on state tests (EXPLANATORY, SPECULATIVE, and PERSUASIVE) is explained in detail. Students are taught what each of these kinds of prompts calls for are shown how to go about composing strong responses. Pathfinder English Language Arts 3-8 is also available in ungraded versions for students who are working below grade level.
